TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT ORDER

The Haringey (Moving Traffic Restrictions) (No. 17) Traffic Order 2023

Made: 11th October 2023

Coming into force: 19th October 2023

The Council of the London Borough of Haringey, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984¹ as amended by the Local Government Act 1985² and the Traffic Management Act 2014³ and of all other powers thereunto enabling, hereby make the following Order:

Citation and Commencement

1. This Order shall come into force on 19th October 2023 and may be cited as The Haringey (Moving Traffic Restrictions) (No. 17) Traffic Order 2023.

Interpretation

2. (1) In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:

"authorised agent" means the parking services contractor appointed by and acting on behalf of the Council for the purposes of the supervision and enforcement of this Order

"Council" means Haringey Council;

"disabled person's badge" has the same meaning as in the Local Authorities' Traffic Orders (Exemptions for Disabled Persons) (England) Regulations 2000⁴

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment;

"goods" means goods of any kind whether animate or inanimate and includes postal packets of any description; and "delivering" and "collecting" in relation to any goods includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;

"motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in section 185(1) of the Road Traffic Act 1988⁵ and section 136(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

"the Order of 2021" means The Haringey (Moving Traffic Restrictions) Order 2021⁶

"map based schedule" means the map attached to and to be read in conjunction with this Order, which depicts the moving restriction which is to be introduced by this Order, and in conjunction with the map schedule legend, which identifies the type of restriction, any permitted exceptions and any specific operating hours.

Provided that the Council does not accept responsibility for any inaccuracies contained in the Ordnance Survey data relied upon to create the map based schedule and where a moving restriction is depicted on the map based schedule, that moving restriction will continue to apply irrespective of any subsequent changes that have been made to the underlying Ordnance Survey data.

"map schedule legend" means the map schedule legend attached to this Order which, when used in conjunction with the map based schedule, identifies the specific type of moving restrictions imposed by this Order and, where appropriate, certain of their governing provisions;

"permit" means a permit issued under the provisions of Article 5 to this Order;

"permit holder" means a person to whom a permit or virtual permit has been issued;

"prescribed hours" means between the hours Mon-Fri 8.30-9.15am 2.45-3.30pm, during school term times;

"prescribed zone" means Zone SS16 and lengths of roads specified in column 2 of Schedule 1 to this Order;

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Haringey on 11th October 2023 has made the above mentioned Orders under sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other powers.

The General Effects of the Order would be: To include property Nos. 51 to 55 Park Avenue (odds) in the list of eligible properties who can apply for a permit to access to the SS16 St Paul's Catholic Primary School Street zone affecting Barratt Avenue N22.

Date of operation: The Orders will come into operation on 19th October 2023.

Application to the high court: Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it does not comply with the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended or that any of the relevant requirements thereof or of any relevant regulations made there under have not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks of the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.
