

**THE HARINGEY (FARRANT AVENUE, GLADSTONE AVENUE, MORLEY AVENUE,
MOSELLE AVENUE N22) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF
TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022**

The Council of the London Borough of Haringey has made the above Temporary Traffic Order under S14(1) Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as described below:-

Farrant Avenue, Gladstone Avenue, Morley Avenue, Moselle Avenue N22
Reason for 14(1) Order – Installation of modular pods for housing development
Operational dates: 3 rd Nov 2022 to 3 rd May 2024 (The temporary restrictions will be introduced in phases and signed accordingly on site) Times: 24hrs or where signed on site
General Effect of Order
<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. To close a 60 metre length of the following roads (the works will be phased and the closure length will move along the stretch of road as each modular pod is installed at the affected address): <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) Morley Avenue N22 between its junction with Vincent Road and Salisbury Road. b) Moselle Avenue N22 between its junction with Vincent Road and Redvers Road. c) Moselle Avenue N22 between its junction with Vincent Road and Salisbury Road. d) Moselle Avenue N22 between its junction with Salisbury Road and Darwin Road. e) Moselle Avenue N22 between its junction with Darwin Road and Lordship Lane. f) Farrant Avenue N22 between its junction with Darwin Road and Lordship Lane. g) Gladstone Avenue N22 between its junction with Vincent Road and Salisbury Road. h) Gladstone Avenue N22 between its junction with Salisbury Road and Darwin Road. 2. To suspend all parking bays and introduce no waiting/no loading on a 60 metre length on both sides of the following roads (the works will be phased and the closure length will move along the stretch of road as each modular pod is installed at the affected address): <ol style="list-style-type: none"> i) Morley Avenue N22 between its junction with Vincent Road and Salisbury Road. j) Moselle Avenue N22 between its junction with Vincent Road and Redvers Road. k) Moselle Avenue N22 between its junction with Vincent Road and Salisbury Road. l) Moselle Avenue N22 between its junction with Salisbury Road and Darwin Road. m) Moselle Avenue N22 between its junction with Darwin Road and Lordship Lane. n) Farrant Avenue N22 between its junction with Darwin Road and Lordship Lane. o) Gladstone Avenue N22 between its junction with Vincent Road and Salisbury Road. p) Gladstone Avenue N22 between its junction with Salisbury Road and Darwin Road. 3. To close Moselle Avenue N22 between the shared property boundary of No.186/188 Moselle Avenue to a point outside No.197 Moselle Avenue. 4. To suspend all parking bays and introduce no waiting/no loading on both sides of Moselle Avenue N22 between the shared property boundary of No.186/188 Moselle Avenue to a point outside No.197 Moselle Avenue.

The provisions of the Orders shall apply only at such times and as directed by traffic signs.

THE HARINGEY (FARRANT AVENUE, GLADSTONE AVENUE, MORLEY AVENUE, MOSELLE AVENUE N22) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2022


Made: 2nd November 2022

Coming into force: 3rd November 2022

The 'Council' of the London Borough of Haringey being the traffic authority for certain roads in that London borough is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near those roads and in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and of all other enabling powers the Council hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order shall come into force on 3rd November 2022 and may be cited as the Haringey (Farrant Avenue, Gladstone Avenue, Morley Avenue, Moselle Avenue N22) (Temporary Prohibition and Restriction of Traffic) Order 2022.
2. Whilst the Order is in force, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to: -
 - (a) enter or proceed in the lengths of roads specified in column 2 of Schedule 1 to this Order during the dates and times specified in column 1 of that Schedule; and
 - (b) wait, load or unload in the lengths of roads specified in column 2 of Schedule 2 to this Order during the dates and times specified in column 1 of that Schedule other than those vehicles exempted from such restrictions specified in column 2 to that Schedule;
3. Whilst this Order is in force, any parking place, loading bay, bus stop, bus stand, bus lane, cycle lane or pedestrian crossing located in a length of road specified in column 2 of Schedule 2 to this Order shall be suspended during the dates and times specified in column 1 of that Schedule.
4. 'The Haringey (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) Order 2021' and 'The Haringey (Charged-For Parking Places) Order 2021' are hereby temporarily amended as detailed in Article 2(b) and 3 to this Order.
5. The prohibitions and restrictions specified in articles 2 and 3 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs as prescribed by The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
6. Nothing in Article 2 to this Order shall apply to: -
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the works;
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
 - (c) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform, a traffic warden or a civil enforcement officer;
 - (d) any vehicle requiring ingress to, and egress from, a property in a prohibited length of road, if the works allow.
7. The Order may continue in force for up to 18 months unless extended by the Secretary of State.
