### THE HARINGEY (B138 HORNSEY PARK ROAD N22, MAYES ROAD N22) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023


Made: 26<sup>th</sup> April 2023

Coming into force: 1<sup>st</sup> May 2023

The 'Council' of the London Borough of Haringey being the traffic authority for certain roads in that London borough is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near those roads and in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and of all other enabling powers the Council hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order shall come into force on 1<sup>st</sup> May 2023 and may be cited as the Haringey (B138 Hornsey Park Road N22, Mayes Road N22) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2023.
2. Whilst the Order is in force, save as provided in Article 4 to this Order no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the lengths of roads specified in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order during the dates and times specified in column 1 of that Schedule; and
3. The prohibitions specified in articles 2 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs as prescribed by The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
4. Nothing in Article 2 to this Order shall apply to: -
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the works;
  - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
  - (c) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform, a traffic warden or a civil enforcement officer;
  - (d) any vehicle requiring ingress to, and egress from, a property in a prohibited length of road, if the works allow.
5. The Order may continue in force for up to 18 months unless extended by the Secretary of State.

The Council of the London Borough of Haringey has made the above Temporary Traffic Order under S14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as described below:-

<b>Reason for 14(1) Order – Resurfacing works</b>	
<b>Operational dates</b>	<b>General Effect of Order</b>
<b>Works duration:</b> 1-2 days <b>Dates:</b> Between Mon 1st May 2023 and Sat 1st July 2023 <b>Times:</b> 24hrs	i) To introduce a road closure on B138 Hornsey Park Road N22 between its junction with the northern kerb line of Malvern Road to its junction with Mayes Road. ii) To introduce a road closure on Mayes Road N22 between its junction with B138 Hornsey Park Road to the south eastern kerblines of Brook Road.

The diversion route will be via Mayes Road, Coburg Road, Western Road, Mary Neuner Road, Clarendon Road, B138, Turnpike Lane, Tottenham Lane, Church Lane, Turnpike Lane, B183 Hornsey Park Road.

The provisions of the Orders shall apply only at such times and as directed by traffic signs. For road closures, alternative routes will be directed by traffic signs.
