**THE HARINGEY (FOOTPATH BETWEEN WHITEHALL STREET AND HEADCORN ROAD N17)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF USE) ORDER 2023**

Made: 22nd February 2023

Coming into force: 27th February 2023

The 'Council' of the London Borough of Haringey being the traffic authority for certain roads in that London borough is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near those roads and in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and of all other enabling powers the Council hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order shall come into force on 27th February 2023 and may be cited as the Haringey (Footpath Between Whitehall Street and Headcorn Road N17) (Temporary Prohibition of Use) Order 2023
2. Whilst the Order is in force, no person shall proceed in the full length of the Footpath between Whitehall Street and Headcorn Road N17.
3. The prohibitions specified in articles 2 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs as prescribed by The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
4. The Order may continue in force for up to 6 months unless extended by the Secretary of State.
