THE HARINGEY (ST JAMES'S LANE N10) (TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2023

Made: 19th July 2023

Coming into force: 27th July 2023

The 'Council' of the London Borough of Haringey being the traffic authority for certain roads in that London borough is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near those roads and in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and of all other enabling powers the Council hereby makes the following Order.

- 1. This Order shall come into force on 27th July 2023 and may be cited as the Haringey (St James's Lane N10) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2023.
- 2. Whilst the Order is in force, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the lengths of roads specified in column 2 of Schedule 1 to this Order during the dates and times specified in column 1 of that Schedule; and
- **3.** The prohibitions and restrictions specified in article 2 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs as prescribed by The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
- 4. Nothing in Article 2 to this Order shall apply to: -
 - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the works;
 - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
 - (c) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform, a traffic warden or a civil enforcement officer;
 - (d) any vehicle requiring ingress to, and egress from, a property in a prohibited length of road, if the works allow.
- 5. The Order may continue in force for up to 18 months unless extended by the Secretary of State.
