Mae Jemison Rocket Ship Craft

YOU WILL NEED

- 1 paper towel roll
- ✤ A roll of foil
- Coloured card (Red, Yellow, Orange, Green and Blue)
- ✤ Glue
- Sticky Tape

STEPS:

1. Grab your paper towel roll and cover it with tin foil.

2. Cut out three blue circles, two green triangles, 1 green circle the size of a roll of masking tape and the fire exhaust from the engines using your red, yellow, and orange card.

3. Make a cut in the circle, to the centre and roll it around to make a cone. This will become the top of the rocket ship. Glue it together to secure the cone.

4. Glue the red, orange, and yellow flame exhaust together. Cut a slit along each side. Slide the fire exhaust up the bottom of the foil tube. Secure it with a piece of clear tape along the back of the rocket ship and the wings.

5. Tape the wings to the sides of the rocket ship using clear tape.

6. Glue the three windows to the front of the rocket ship.

7. Glue the top of the rocket ship to the top of the foil tube by putting glue along the top rim of the tube. Hold the top cone in place for a minute or two to secure it.

Caution: Adult supervision will be required when using scissors. Small parts can be a choking hazard. Do not leave children unattended during project.
