## Proposed Road Safety Improvements on Cranley Gardens, N10

Dear Resident or Business,

I would like to thank all who participated in the original public and statutory consultation exercise conducted from 14 December 2022 until 18 January 2023, on proposals to introduce sinusoidal speed humps along Cranley Gardens, in order to reduce vehicular speeds and improve road safety.

We considered all feedback received during the consultation period and the Council has decided to proceed with the implementation of the proposed speed reducing measures on Cranley Gardens, as detailed on the plan overleaf.
