# THE HARINGEY (STANHOPE ROAD, AVENUE ROAD N6-TTMO239) (TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF TRAFFIC) ORDER 2024

Made: 13<sup>th</sup> March 2024

Coming into force: 18th March 2024

The 'Council' of the London Borough of Haringey being the traffic authority for certain roads in that London borough is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near those roads and in exercise of its powers under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and of all other enabling powers the Council hereby makes the following Order.

- 1. This Order shall come into force on 18th March 2024 and may be cited as the Haringey (Stanhope Road, Avenue Road N6-TTMO239) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2024
- 2. Whilst the Order is in force, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to: -
  - (a) wait, load or unload in the lengths of roads specified in column 2 of Schedule 1 to this Order during the dates and times specified in column 1 of that Schedule other than those vehicles exempted from such restrictions specified in column 2 to that Schedule;
  - (b) wait or load in the lengths of roads specified in column 2 of Schedule 2 to this Order during the dates and times specified in column 1 of that Schedule other than those vehicles exempted from such restrictions specified in column 3 of that Schedule. These areas are to be bounded on one side of that length by the edge of the carriageway and having a width throughout of 1.83 metres and are temporarily designated as a parking place.
- **3.** Whilst this Order is in force, any parking place or waiting restrictions located in a length of road specified in column 2 of Schedule 2 to this Order shall be suspended during the dates and times specified in column 1 of that Schedule.
- 4. 'The Haringey (Free Parking Places, Loading Places and Waiting, Loading and Stopping Restrictions) Order 2021' and 'The Haringey (Charged-For Parking Places) Order 2021' are hereby temporarily amended as detailed in Article 2 and 3 to this Order.
- **5.** The prohibitions and restrictions specified in articles 2 and 3 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs as prescribed by The Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
- 6. Nothing in Article 2 to this Order shall apply to: -
  - (a) any vehicle being used in connection with the works;
  - (b) any vehicle being used for fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes;
  - (c) anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform, a traffic warden or a civil enforcement officer;
  - (d) any vehicle requiring ingress to, and egress from, a property in a prohibited length of road, if the works allow.
- 7. Nothing in Article 2(b) to this Order shall apply to any vehicle exempted from the restrictions as defined in column 3 of Schedule 2 to this Order;
- 8. The Order may continue in force for up to 18 months unless extended by the Secretary of State.

Mon 18 <sup>th</sup> March 2024 to Fri 20 <sup>th</sup> Dec 2024 Time: 24hrs	<ol> <li>To suspend all parking and introduce no waiting/no loading at any time on both sides of Stanhope Road N6 between its junction with Claremont Road and its junction with Wychwood End.</li> <li>To suspend all parking and introduce No Waiting/No Loading at Any Time on north side of Avenue Road N6 from its junction with Stanhope Road to a point opposite the shared property boundary of No.45/43.</li> <li>To relocate the bikehangar on the northeast side of Stanhope Road N6 from opposite Parkgate Mews to the western end of the Resident Permit Holder Only bays opposite No.45/47 Avenue Road N6. The bikehangar is 2 metres wide and 2.5 metres in length.</li> </ol>
