MAIN PURPOSE OF THE JOB

To ensure the safety, welfare and physical and mental wellbeing of the children and all users of the Centre.

You will be required to undertake a range of duties:

Assist in the general care of children

Prepare and set up inside and out

Cleaning

Domestic work

Supporting the work of the Nursery Officer staff

Other associated duties

o You will need to be strong enough to:

Move furniture in and out of storage areas

Clean floors and all other surfaces thoroughly.

DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

CHILDREN: all duties will be under the direction of the Nursery Officer and Teaching Staff.

- 1. Support the Nursery staff in the general care and education of young children attending to their personal needs, including social, health, physical, hygiene, first aid and welfare matters.
- 2. Help in setting out, tidying up and cleaning up activities for the children.
- 3. Change and rinse out soiled and dirty clothes.
- 4. Ensure the health & safety of the children at all times, keeping hazards out of reach and ensuring that doors and gates are closed or locked where necessary.
- 5. Be aware of policies in relation to the care of children.
- 6. Accompanying children from school to school
- 7. Make and maintain displays, labels and resources

MEALTIMES: All duties will be under the direction of the Nursery Officer and Teaching staff.

- 1. To set up and tidy away the mealtime furniture.
- 2. To serve meals to children and to prepare and serve light snacks, ensuring that high standards of food hygiene are followed.

- 3. To help children a mealtimes.
- 4. To clean up spillages when food and drinks are dropped or spilt.

CLEANING:

- 1. To vacuum carpets, wash and clean floors, paint-work, work surfaces and toys. Generally ensure that the rooms are kept safe, clean and tidy.
- 2. To clean sinks, toilets, hand basins and potties.
- 3. To report any hazards or defects to the room co-ordinator and Head of Centre.

Arrangements for appraisal of performance:

There is an annual appraisal cycle carried out by line mangers which seeks to acknowledge success, resolve problems and identify training/development needs.
