- Guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Universal Credit provided that you have a annual net earned income of less than £7,400 (616.67 per month)
- If you are supported by NASS under Part V1 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999. You must provide your NASS number.

If your child is transferring to secondary school in September 2024, and you live in Haringey, you can also apply for a one-off clothing grant of £60. The closing date for a clothing grant is 31 March 2025.

You do not need to send us evidence of your benefits at this stage - we'll let you know if we need more information.
