More than 80% of L-shape modular pods installed

We're continuing our work with our contractors Equans to complete phase 1 of the Noel Park estate programme.

Progress has been made and we're now closer to completing the first phase of the works while the second phase has already started.

In numbers:

- → 81% of L-shape pods installed
- → 14% of double pods installed
- → 77% of external works on Gladstone Avenue (phase 1) completed
- → 10% of external works on Gladstone Avenue (phase 2) completed
- → 75% of kitchen renewal works (phase 1) completed
- → 34% of kitchen renewal works (phase 2) completed

Up and coming works:

The external works are drawing to a close on the current batch of properties which means scaffolding will start to come down over the coming weeks. Modular replacements will continue on a weekly basis, with road closures still taking place, keep an eye out for more information on the notice boards.

We're continuing with the phase 2 external works on Gladstone Avenue, followed up by the installation of double pods. The outstanding kitchen installations to properties along Gladstone Avenue will recommence and run until September 2024.

Key information:

→ Windows

Please make sure windows are closed while repairs are being made to the external brickwork of your home. This is to reduce dust, debris and noise as well as to protect your privacy.

→ Keep your home ventilated

We recommend that once your new windows have been installed, the vents are left open as often as possible to reduce potential condensation.



Scaffold safety

Please do not attempt to climb or access our scaffolding at any time. Access is strictly prohibited for residents and members of the public for safety reasons.

This applies particularly to children. Any unauthorised persons accessing the scaffolding outside of our normal working hours of Monday to Friday 8am-5pm should be reported to the Police immediately.

Bogus callers

You should be wary of bogus callers – they are people that pretend to be someone they are not in order to gain entry to your home!

To help protect you against bogus callers, Equans take the following precautions:

- ☑ Ensure all our staff carry an official Equans ID badge with full face photo. They will also be wearing official Equans numbered hi-viz vests.
- Always book an appointment with you in advance, during our usual working hours.
- ☑ Provide back up if you doubt a caller claiming to be from Equans is genuine and they cannot produce valid ID. Do not let them into your home, contact us straight away or if out of hours, call the Police on 101.

Remember, if in doubt - keep them out!
