
Proposed Bikehangar (Cycle Parking Storage) – 2024/25 Batch 1

Dear Resident or Business,

Encouraging more people to cycle is an important part of the central Government and Haringey Councils policy to help tackle traffic congestion, improve air quality, promote physical activity, and improve accessibility. However, many residents particularly those who live in flats find it difficult to keep bicycles at home due to lack of storage space. In response to this challenge the Council has established programme to provide more secure cycle storage (Bikehangar) on street for residents' use.

As part of this years' cycle parking programme, we are proposing to install Bikehangers at 31 locations across the borough. These locations are provided below as part of this letter. The locations were selected based on requests received from local residents.

Cycle Storage/Bikehangar

Bike hangars are communal bike lockers offering storage for six bicycles. A single Bikehangar unit occupies less than one car parking space. The units are easy to open as they have self-lifting doors, and the steel design protects cycles from vandalism, theft and wet weather.
