Works Notice and Outcome of Statutory Consultation

Introduction Crouch End A (CEA) CPZ review measures

Dear Resident/Business.

I am writing to let you know that we will soon be introducing additional waiting and loading restrictions in your area.

Feedback from the consultation we undertook

In November 2022, we carried out a public engagement with the community in general, the overall majority fell that the existing parking controls in Crouch End A are working fine, and days or hours of operation do not need to be changed.

In response to concerns raised about congestion and safety on the Broadway and Topsfield Parade, the Council recommended extending existing waiting and loading restrictions to include Sunday. This is to ensure the safety of all road users and ensure safe accessibility for essential services such as emergency services, public transport, and essential Council services such as refuse collections.

We undertook the statutory consultation in April and May 2024, this resulted in three objections being received. Officers considered the objections received and a decision report produced and approved in line with the Councils constitution. Introduction of new measures.

New measures will be introduced to alleviate traffic congestion on Broadway and Topsfield parades during Sundays, while also enhancing safety at critical junctions identified during the initial public engagement process.

The new measures will include:

- Increase existing waiting and loading restrictions (Monday to Saturday 8am to 6.30pm) to Monday Sunday 8am to 6.30pm on Broadway Parade and Topsfield Parade
- Increase the lengths of 'at any time' restrictions (double yellow lines) at the following locations to improve safety, visibility, and accessibility for all road users.
- Middle Lane Junction with Chestnut Avenue.
- Weston Park Junction with Elder Ave

When will we start implementing these changes.

We are scheduled to begin implementing these changes on **Monday, August 26, 2024**. The work on site will involve painting road markings and installing signs and posts. We anticipate that this process will take approximately four days to complete, and we are committed to minimising any disruptions during this period
