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Section 3: Disability Access Fund Declaration (DAF)

Two-three-and-four-year old children who are in receipt of **Child Disability Living Allowance (CDLA)**, and are receiving the free entitlement are eligible for the Disability Access Fund (**DAF**). **DAF** is paid to the child's early years setting at a fixed annual rate. The current rate is £881.00 per eligible child. This will rise to £910.00 from 1st April 2024 per eligible child.

Section 4: Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP)

The government introduced EYPP to help raise the attainment of disadvantaged pupils of all abilities to reach their full potential. If you have three-and-four-year-olds from low-income families at your setting, you may be eligible for EYPP currently at **£376.20 per year, per eligible child** until 31st March 2024.

From 1 April 2024 the amount paid will be **£387.60 per year, per eligible child**.

Note: From 1 April 2024 providers can apply to receive Early Years Pupil Premium for two-year-old children from low-income families.

Children will be eligible for EYPP if they receive the universal 15 hours entitlement, and they meet the eligibility criteria.

A child may also be eligible for Early Years Pupil Premium if they are currently being looked after by a local authority in England or Wales or if the child has left care in England or Wales through:

- adoption
- special guardianship order
- a child arrangements order

EYPP is payable on the universal 15 hours entitlement only and not on any additional entitlement hours (i.e. 30-hour offer) for working parents.

Please ensure that the personal details of the parent/carer have been added to the Parental Agreement Form to indicate they have given their consent for an eligibility check.

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Section 5: Early Years Free Entitlement Details

The Free Entitlement funding is for a maximum of 38 weeks a year only, and a maximum of 15/30hrs per week can be claimed. Providers can agree with parents/carers to stretch this offer over the year – but it's not mandatory and is subject to the providers delivery model.

The child can attend a maximum of two childcare settings and if the child attends more than one setting; funding will be split fairly between the two. Complete the appropriate section below.
