## PROPOSED PROHIBITION OF MOTOR VEHICLES – VARIOUS ROADS, TOTTENHAM HOTSPUR STADIUM N17 The Haringey (Moving Traffic Restrictions) (Amendment No.\*) Order 202\*

**Notice is hereby given** that the Council of the London Borough of Haringey proposes to make the above mentioned Order under sections 6, 22C, 22D and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

**The general effect of the Order:** To prohibit motor vehicles from entering the following roads in the London Borough of Haringey during specified times depending on the type of Major Event being held at Tottenham Hotspur Stadium. These locations will be enforced with a combination of Hostile Vehicle Mitigation, rising bollards and Traffic Management vehicle (Footways at locations no.1-8 and no.13-18 will also be closed). The restrictions contained within this proposed order will supersede the current Major Event Anti-Terrorism Traffic Order (ATTRO) in place. *“Major Event” means a Football or Rugby, NFL game or Concert event which is planned to take place or which is taking place at Tottenham Hotspur Stadium, with an expected attendance of 10,000 persons or more, not including any staff or contractors engaged in either the operation or management of the aforementioned Stadium or event.*

**Statement of Reasons**

The proposed anti-terrorism traffic management order is proposed in order to comply with a request from the Commissioner of Police to potentially control the movement of pedestrians and vehicles on the streets within the Tottenham Hotspur Stadium Traffic Management Zone as part of a package of measures aimed at improving the security of people in crowded places and protecting damage to buildings from a potential terrorist attack during major events relating to Football or Rugby/NFL/Concerts held at the Stadium.

The proposed order would give to an officer of the Police of the rank of Inspector or above the power to restrict all or part of any street at their discretion described within the order on the basis of a security assessment or intelligence of a threat. The discretion must be exercised in accordance with any agreed Protocol for the time being in force to ensure that any interference is proportionate and that such restrictions are for the minimum extent and for the minimum period necessary.

The Council of the London Borough of Haringey, after consulting the Commissioner of Police of the Metropolis, in exercise of powers conferred by sections 6, 22C, 22D and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and of all other enabling powers, hereby make the following Order:-

**Citation and Commencement**

1. This Order shall come into force on \*\*\*\*\* and may be cited as The Haringey (Moving Traffic Restrictions) (Amendment No.\*) Order 202\*.

**Interpretation**

2. (1) In this Order, except where the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the meanings hereby respectively assigned to them:

"enactment" means any enactment, whether public general or local, and includes any order, byelaw, rule, regulation, scheme or other instrument having effect by virtue of an enactment and any reference in this Order to any enactment shall be construed as a reference to that enactment as amended, applied, consolidated, re-enacted by or as having effect by virtue of any subsequent enactment;

"Event Day" means a day on which a Major Football or Rugby Event/Major NFL Event/Concert is taking place at Tottenham Hotspur Stadium;

"Event Day Commander" means the Senior Officer of the Metropolitan Police Service appointed as the principal co-ordinator of policing and traffic management activities within the Tottenham Hotspur Stadium Traffic Management Zone on an Event Day;

"Concert" means a concert which is planned to take place or which is taking place at Tottenham Hotspur Stadium, with an expected attendance of 10,000 persons or more, not including any staff or contractors engaged in either the operation or management of the aforementioned Stadium or event;

"Major Football or Rugby Event" means a football or rugby event which is planned to take place or which is taking place at Tottenham Hotspur Stadium, with an expected attendance of 10,000 persons or more, not including any staff or contractors engaged in either the operation or management of the aforementioned Stadium or event;

"Major NFL Event" means an NFL event which is planned to take place or which is taking place at Tottenham Hotspur Stadium, with an expected attendance of 10,000 persons or more, not including any staff or contractors engaged in either the operation or management of the aforementioned Stadium or event;

"goods" means goods of any kind whether animate or inanimate and includes postal packets of any description; and "delivering" and "collecting" in relation to any goods includes checking the goods for the purpose of their delivery or collection;

"motor vehicle" has the same meaning as in section 185(1) of the Road Traffic Act 1988(c) and section 136(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984;

"prescribed hours related to Major Football or Rugby Event" means a Major Football or Rugby Event Day commencing 2 hours in advance of the published start time of a Major Event and ending 1 hour after the conclusion of said event, or as specified by the Event Day Commander;

"prescribed hours related to Major NFL Event" means a Major NFL Event Day commencing up to Up to 10 hours in advance of published start time of a Major Event and ending up to 90 mins after the conclusion of said event, or as specified by the Event Day Commander;

“prescribed hours related to Concerts” means a Concert Event Day commencing up to 4 hours in advance of the published start time of a Major Event and ending up to 2 hour after the conclusion of said event, or as specified by the Event Day Commander;

“prescribed street” means a street, road or length thereof referred to in Article 3 or in the Schedule to this Order;

"telecommunication system" has the same meaning as in the Telecommunications Act 1984(d);

“Tottenham Hotspur Stadium Traffic Management Zone” means an area of streets or roads in the vicinity of Tottenham Hotspur Stadium, comprising the streets, roads and lengths thereof referred to in this Order, each of which is subject to certain restrictions during the prescribed hours on Event Days, as provided by this Order

- (2) The prohibitions imposed by this Order are in addition to and not in derogation of any restriction, prohibition or requirement imposed by any other enactment and any exception or exemption from the provisions of this Order is without prejudice to the provisions of any other enactment.

### **Prohibition of Motor Vehicles**

3. Save as provided in Article 7 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter into or proceed in the prescribed street as detailed in Schedule 1 to this Order during the prescribed hours related to Major Football or Rugby Event.
4. Save as provided in Article 7 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter into or proceed in the prescribed street as detailed in Schedule 2 to this Order during the prescribed hours related to Major NFL Event.
5. Save as provided in Article 7 of this Order no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter into or proceed in the prescribed street as detailed in Schedule 3 to this Order during the prescribed hours related to Concerts.
6. No person shall proceed or enter the footway in the London Borough of Haringey as detailed in items 1 to 8 in Schedule 1 & 3 and items 1 to 14 in Schedule 2 to this Order during the prescribed hours.

### **Exemptions**

7. Nothing in Articles 3,4, 5 or 6 shall apply:
  - (a) to any motor vehicle when used for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes attending incidents at Tottenham Hotspur Stadium or properties within the Tottenham Hotspur Stadium Traffic Management Zone;
  - (b) to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform;

### **Revocation**

8. The Haringey (Moving Traffic Restrictions) (No. 16) Traffic Order 2022 is hereby revoked. All restrictions shall continue in force by virtue of this Order.
