- In accordance with Regulation 20 of The Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012 (as amended), this statement hereby gives notice that on 20 July 2017 the London Borough of Haringey made (i.e. adopted) the Highgate Neighbourhood Plan for the designated neighbourhood area.
- 2. The Highgate Neighbourhood Area was formally designated on 18 December 2012.
- 3. This statement confirms that the Highgate Neighbourhood Plan has legal effect as part of Haringey's statutory Development Plan for the designated area. Development proposals located within the designated area will therefore be determined in accordance with the Development Plan unless material considerations indicate otherwise.
